Old and new business

Proposed amendments to the Bylaws.

Doug briefly described the background and approval process for the proposed amendments:

- These amendments are proposed by the Board
- Approval by the APFGA membership is required
- The sign-in sheet and a head count confirmed 31 people present at the time this discussion began, thus constituting the required 15% quorum of the 169 paid members
- It was announced that 19 votes (i.e. 60% of those present) would be required for approval of any proposed amendment
- As noted in the distributed agenda, the amendments fall into 4 different areas for discussion (a fifth proposed amendment has been removed from consideration due to discovery of a conflict with State Statute)
- There will be an up or down vote on each amended area in the bylaws
- Amendment proposal #1 Article III, Clause (2) "Dues"
 Clarification of payment of dues and membership rights, and added language pertaining to Lifetime Paid memberships
 - Motion to Approve as presented in the 30-day notice
 - Moved by David Evans, seconded by Mike Carr
 - Motion passed unanimously to approve as presented
- 2. Amendment proposal #2 Article IV, Clause (3) "Meeting Notice"

 Authorization for use of email notification of members for any required notices
 - Motion to Approve as presented in the 30-day notice
 - Moved by Bob Daniel, seconded by Debbie Hinchey
 - Motion to amend the original motion by deleting this sentence from the proposal:
 "U.S. Postal Service mail will not be used for any communication between the Board and the membership."
 - Moved by Dan Eliot, seconded by Susan Miller
 - Passed with 30 in favor, no votes against, for amending the original motion
 - Amended Motion passed with 27 votes in favor, 3 votes against, and 1 abstaining, for approval of the proposed amendment without the noted sentence

- 3. Amendment proposal #3 Article V, Clause (7) "Elections and Appointment of Directors" Establishes 2-year board member terms with alternating election of 3 and 4 members each year
 - Motion to Approve as presented in the 30-day notice
 - Moved by Dan Elliot, seconded by Bob Daniel
 - Motion passed unanimously to approve as presented
- 4. Amendment proposal #4 Article VI, Clause (1) "Officers"

 This proposal was withdrawn and removed from further consideration after learning that it conflicted with Alaska Statute Sec. 10.20.121 for Nonprofit Corporations
- 5. Amendment proposal #5 Miscellaneous edits for clarification of language and syntax:

 Article IV, Clause (5) re-state a 5% rule rather than "1/20th" standard

 Article IV, Clause (6) clarifies normal annual meeting occurs on second Thursday in November

 Article V, Clause (2) replaces "in good standing" with "paid" for board member qualification

 Article VI, Clause (4) re-states the sentence for clarity

 Article VI, Clause (9) Removes board members from reference to "one year terms"

 Article V, Clause (11) clarifies board committee actions do not constitute board or club actions

 Article X, Clause (1) simplifies the language for process of bylaw amendments

 Article X, Clause (2) removes explicit citation of Alaska Statutes without removing compliance
 - Motion to Approve all miscellaneous edits as presented in the 30-day notice
 - Moved by Gary Masoog, seconded by Karen Leis
 - Motion to amend the original motion by removing the proposed amendments for Article X, Clause (1) and Clause (2), for separate question
 - Moved by Dan Eliot, seconded by Bob Daniel
 - Passed unanimously to amend the original motion
 - Amended Motion passed unanimously for miscellaneous edits as presented and without the proposed Article X edits
 - Motion to Approve miscellaneous edits in Article X as presented in the 30-day notice
 - Moved byMike Carr, seconded by Karen Leis
 - Motion passed with 25 votes in favor, 5 votes against, approval of amendments to Article X Clause (1) & Clause (2)
