C. Reports of officers

Treasurer Report: Gary Masog

- \$106k CD renewal Unanimous vote by board: Gary has discretion to renew no later than the end of January to capture the best rate (December rate currently 3.5% for 1 year).
- We have pre-paid \$3,300 for rootstock for 2023.

President Report: GLExpo

- MW provided written notes to the Board covering main points of what he learned.
- MW highlight: met premiere Michigan cherry grower at breakfast
- Zestar observation: does better in colder climate. Water may be the bigger factor for fruit texture than sunlight in AK.
- Too large of a fruit set on cherries can lead to softer fruit. If you see heavy clusters of cherries, they should be thinned.
- Tiana Dupont: presentations on soils, root uptake points, ground covers relevant to AK. Read Jeff Lowenfels new book on roots, nutrient uptake, etc.
- Apple tastings: none of the varieties were suitable for AK (long season) and many very sweet, not good for drying. Varieties are largely market driven.
- Grandpa's Orchard: has some unique grafting tools available that might be useful for our clinic. Mark will provide prices.
